Applicants MUST submit:

- i. provisional title of the Doctoral Thesis and scientific area(s) it pertains
- ii. the proposed drafting and writing language (which might be other than Greek) and
- iii. the proposed supervisor whose subject or scientific field is relevant to that of the D.T. to be prepared, according to article 34, Law 5128/2024 (A'118/30-7-2024)

The required documents are:

- 1. Photo (colored)
- 2. A photocopy of the applicant's ID Card
- 3. Detailed Curriculum Vitae
- Copies of undergraduate and postgraduate degrees with diploma/degree grades, certified by the legally competent authority. In case of foreign institutions degrees a certificate of equivalence is required from the legally competent authority
- 5. Certificate of Analytical Scores received as part of the Degree
- 6. Certificate(s) of proficiency in foreign language(s).
- 7. Two (2) letters of recommendation, at least one from academia
- 8. Short draft of the thesis (at least subject/area, problem and objectives should be included) up to 5 pages.
- Desired username (only characters, no symbols or spaces) to access the online services of the NTUA once they are accepted (in case of NTUA postgraduate students they should use their postgraduate username).

Applicants will be invited to an interview by the Sector's competent committee after the expiration of the online registration dates.
